Your USI VET transcript

What is a USI?

Your Unique Student Identifier (USI) is your personal education number. It's required for all nationally recognised study, including university and vocational education and training (VET).

What is a USI VET transcript?

A USI VET transcript shows all your completed nationally recognised training since 2015. It does not show your university studies.

Use your VET transcript to:

- apply for a credit transfer
- demonstrate pre-requisites for future training
- backup original documentation
- show proof of qualifications to employers and others
- minimise unnecessary retraining.











How to share your VET transcript

Sharing your VET transcript is a convenient and secure way to prove your qualifications to potential employers and demonstrate pre-requisites for further training.

- 1 Log in to your USI account via the USI Student Portal.
- 2 Select 'view VET transcript'.
- 3 Read and acknowledge the Transcript Disclaimer, select 'next'.
- In the VET transcript details area, use the check boxes on the left to select all training records for a full VET transcript, or specific training records for a VET transcript extract.
- 5 Select 'download transcript'.
- 6 Select 'yes' to 'do you want to create a viewable VET transcript?'.
- 7 Choose a relevant time for the VET transcript to be accessible for.
- 8 Select 'next' and 'continue'.
